What is an Abbey Mass Card and how are they used?

An Abbey Mass card, also known as a memorial card or a remembrance card, is a greeting card given to someone to let them know that he or she, or a deceased loved-one, will be remembered at the Abbey's Community Mass. These cards are available in the back of the Church and by the reception desk in the Spirituality Center. The card itself is then sent to the person to be remembered (or the family of the deceased). Along with the card also comes an insert (asking for the name of the person to be remembered and a requested donation) and this is mailed to the Abbey in the smaller envelope provided. If you get your card at the Spirituality Center desk, you can fill out the return slip there and simply give the smaller envelope to the receptionist.
